- Training Course, Abseil Module and Assessment course available
- Covering Supervision, Management of activities, Bouldering and the teaching of basic movement skills and roped climbing. Excluding lead climbing
- This will allow you to bring your own groups indoor climbing, Bouldering and Abseiling

This scheme is for climbers who are in or would like to be in a position of responsibility when supervising climbing activities on indoor climbing walls and artificial towers and boulders. It is primarily concerned with ensuring good practice, leading to the safe enjoyment of climbing activities and to an understanding of the sport.

It covers the supervision and management of the activities such as bouldering, the teaching of basic movement skills and roped climbing excluding lead climbing.

In addition to the CWA training course we provide a 1 day CWA Assessment and we also offer the additional Abseil module which can be taken after the CWA Assessment.

Participants are required to be a minimum of top rope competent and 17 years or older with some lead climbing experience. Participants are required to take part in a training course, then have a period of consolidation to gather additional experience after which you can choose to take your assessment.
