Membership form: 4 Rules

General and Top Rope Rules

1. Climbers are welcome on the understanding that the centre can not be held responsible for an individuals own action.
2. Climbers are to take responsibility for them selves and must not take unnecessary risks beyond their own capability.
3. Be aware of other climbers, giveway to people climbing above you.
4. Bouldering is only allowed in the boulder room and above the orange mat in the training room.
5. Top rope climbers are not allowed to lead climb or lead belay.
6. Lower off at a steady rate to avoid scorching ropes and injury.
7. All persons in the climbing areas must be aware of other climbers.
8. All bags must be kept in a locker or in the meeting room and not in the main area.
9. Do not attempt to swap or remove holds.
10. All loose holds to be reported to a member of staff.
11. Recommended equipment.

Footwear	Climbing shoes or clean trainers
Harnesses	Sit harnesses or full body harnesses
Helmets	Climbers are recommended to wear helmets for protection
Belaying	Only recommended devices to be used and no Italian Hitches.
12. Entry tickets must be displayed.
13. If you are unsure about anything please see a member of staff.
14. Jewellery must be removed before climbing to avoid damage or injury.
15. All persons in the climbing areas must be aware of climbers above and around them.
16. Members should behave in a considerate manner to retain the friendly atmosphere of the centre.

Lead Climbing Rules

1. Lead climbing is not permitted on centre ropes.
2. When lead climbing, all protection points relating to the route climbed must be clipped.
3. When lead climbing the lower off at the end of each route must be clipped,
4. No more than one rope to be clipped into the lower off at any one time.(Unless using half / double ropes.)
5. Seconding a lead climb must be done using the end of the rope which is clipped through the quickdraws.
6. No seconding a lead climb if the rope is not through the lower off.
7. Belayers should not be any more than 3 meters from the base of the wall.
8. If you are using double/half ropes please double them up and use as one rope.
9. Lower off at a steady rate to avoid scorching ropes and injury.

Bouldering Rules

1. Do not run in the boulder room.
2. No play fighting or gymnastics on the mats.
3. Do not climb on top of the boulder or behind the walls.
4. If possible climb down from the top of your boulder problems.
5. Beware of other climbers, avoid being underneath climbers.
6. Do not overcrowd any one area.
7. All climbing hardware must be removed. (Harnesses etc.)
8. Do not jump from the slab at any time.
9. Stand well back from other climbers while waiting you turn.
10. Please behave in a considerate manner to retain the friendly atmosphere of the centre.
11. All persons under 14years old must be supervised at all times.
